"Travel blogging has come a long way in a very short period of time and having a chance to get over 50 top travel bloggers together to talk about trends, techniques, and methods to improve our craft and our professionalism is vital in the process of growing or profession. Additionally, today travel bloggers play an important role in the decision making process for individuals making travel decisions and having the opportunity for bloggers to be able to network with the many sponsors of this event and help educate those in the travel industry for the value of working with professional travel bloggers, is an opportunity that we are all looking forward to," he added.

"There is such variety geographically in a limited area. There are very few places in the world that you can do as much as you can do in one country as you can in Sri Lanka. You can have beach activities in one day and then go inland, I hiked Adams peak one year. It had one of the top five sunrises I have ever seen in my lifetime," he added.
